Duties and Responsibilities

PICU nurses at our organization are expected to perform the following duties:

- Assist with patient admission, documenting their medical history and physical assessment findings in the electronic health record (EHR)
- Collect vital signs and report any abnormal findings to the medical team
- Administer IV, PO, and IO medications, taking note of any allergies or medication contraindications
- Manage artificial airways like endotracheal tubes and tracheostomies and ensure adequate oxygenation
- Assist with bedside procedures like catheter insertions, chest tube placements, head ultrasounds, and echocardiograms

- Feed patients and document their intake volume
- Educate parents on the plan of care and involve them in treatment interventions when possible

Compensation and Shifts

- Starting salary of \$90,000, with adjustments made for relevant education and experience
- Full-time employment, working three scheduled 12-hour shifts per week (7a-7p)
- Overtime, holiday, and incentive pay available
- Night and weekend shift differential
